SAFETY PRECAUTIONS FOR USE OF PLOW DISK COOKER

Do's:

- Read CCC assembly instructions carefully.
- Read Burner care and use instructions at www.thebayou.com or call (800) 864-6194.
- Read High Pressure Hose Regulator and Valve Assembly Instruction Manual.
- If you smell gas, shut off the Propane bottle.
- Do follow operation rules using your Cooker and it will provide you with a lifetime of use.
- Clean and inspect the hose and the cooker before each use.
- Have a safe time cooking on your Outdoor Cowtown Custom Cooker

Don'ts:

- **DO NOT** leave oil and grease unattended.
- **DO NOT** store or use gasoline or flammable liquids, or vapors within 20 feet of the cooker.
- **DO NOT** tamper with or attempt to repair on LP gas product.
- **DO NOT** allow the oil or grease to exceed 350° F.
- **DO NOT** cook indoors with the cooker.
- **DO NOT** store LP Cylinder indoors. The cylinder **MUST** be stored outdoors.
- **DO NOT** put this cooker under any overhead construction. Keep minimum clearance of 10 feet from the sides, front, and back of the cooker.
- **DO NOT** move the cooker while cooking or when the cooker is still hot. Also, **DO NOT** remove the disc while still hot.
- **DO NOT** allow small children closer than 10 feet from Cooker at all times.
- **DO NOT** deep fry with 22" standard Disc. We make a 24" Deep Disc for frying. See website for Frying Disc and Fish Fry combos.

- **DO NOT** exceed more than a ½ gallon of cooking oil in 24" Deep Frying Disc.
- **DO NOT** allow anyone under 18 years of age to use or cook on cooker.
